

2018 - New Archery Program Information

1. Updated Process for Stand Site Selection:

- a. The order of selecting stand sites is now part of the lottery used to determine which conservation area an individual hunter or group of hunters is drawn to hunt at.
- b. The order that hunters or groups are pulled in that lottery drawing will also be used to determine the order for selecting a hunting stand site.

- a. Scheduled for September 15th, 2018 to place stickers and identify your hunting stand location:

 - ii. Distillery Road Conservation Area: 9:00 a.m. to 9:40 a.m.
 - iii. Ipsen Road & Newburg Village: 9:45 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.
 - iv. Rainbow Gardens: 10:00 to 10:45 a.m.
 - v. Kinnikinnick Creek Cons. Area: 11:00 to 11:45 a.m.
 - vi. Lib Conservation Area: Noon to 12:30 p.m.
 - vii. Piscasaw Fen Cons. Area: 12:30 p.m. to 1:00 p.m.
 - viii. Ballard Farm Cons. Area: 1:00 p.m. to 1:20 p.m.
 - ix. Kishwaukee Valley Cons. Area: 1:30 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.
 - x. East County Line Cons. Area: 2:00 p.m. to 2:15 p.m.
 - xi. Funderburg Cons. Area: 2:15 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.
 - xii. Sewell Cons. Area: 2:30 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.

3. Review of Program Safety Criteria:

- a. Hunters will be provided a Program Safety Review Guide on the September 15, 2018 during the stand placement process. This will replace the safety meeting that has traditionally been a part of this archery hunt program.
