

2019 – 2020 Archery Program Information

1. Process for Stand Site Selection:

- a. The order of selecting stand sites is now part of the lottery used to determine which conservation area an individual hunter or group of hunters is drawn to hunt at.
- b. The order that hunters or groups are pulled in that lottery drawing will also be used to determine the order for selecting a hunting stand site.
- c. Additional details are included in the updated rules & regulations.

2. Stand Selection Date and Times:

- a. Scheduled at the Gustafson Nature Center – 603 North Appleton Road in Belvidere on Saturday, September 14th, 2019 to place stickers and identify your hunting stand location:

3. Review of Program Safety Criteria:

- a. Hunters will be provided a Program Safety Review Guide on Saturday, September 14, 2019 during the stand placement process. This will replace the safety meeting that has traditionally been a part of this archery hunt program.

4. New Hunting Sites:

- a. Silberhorn Conservation Area: 25-acres; 2 individual hunters or one group.
- b. Luckey Woods Conservation Area: 25-acres; 2 individual hunters or one group.
