ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR CORPORATE FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE 1ST DAY OF APRIL, A.D. 2018 AND ENDING THE 31ST DAY OF MARCH, A.D., 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE BOONE COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT:

SECTION I: That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, to defray all expense and liabilities of the BOONE COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT, be and the same is hereby levied for the purposes hereinafter specified against all taxable property in the County of Boone, State of Illinois, as the same is equalized and assessed for State and County purposes for the fiscal year commencing on the 1st day of April, A.D., 2018 and ending the 31st day of March, A.D. 2019.

Said taxes hereby levied are the current fiscal year of said District commencing April 1, 2018 and ending March 31, 2019 and are to be applied in liquidation of the Insurance Account appropriation hereto made by the aforementioned Ordinance No.135 passed by the Board of Trustees for the insurance purposes as authorized by the aforesaid "Local Governmental and Governmental Employee Immunity Tort Act", as amended.
