



BOONE COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT

Regulations Governing Use of its Land Ordinance #91

Hours: Conservation District sites shall be open to the public one half hour before sunrise to one half and hour after sunset, or as posted

IT IS UNLAWFUL TO:

1. Have unleashed pets on district lands.
2. Horseback ride unless it is on designated bridle trails.
3. Picnic in any area other than established picnic areas.
4. Reserve tables for more than one hour prior to use.
5. Hold group activities of more than 25 people without a permit.
6. Build fires in any area other than those designated.
7. Advertise or solicit business.
8. Camp without permit.
9. Bring in, use, or possess illegal drugs and alcoholic beverages including beer, and wine.
10. Harm, remove or disturb any building, equipment, sign, markers, barricades, or structures.
11. Hold activities or use electronic devices so as to disturb other visitors.
12. Use loud speakers or public address systems.
13. Operate metal detectors and radio controlled recreation devices without a permit.
14. Bring in any weapons, including firearms, paint ball guns, air guns, blow guns, bows and arrows, crossbows, spears or knives, firecrackers, fireworks, smoke bombs, rockets etc .
15. Operate a motor vehicle recklessly, above the posted limit or park outside the established roadways and parking areas. Handicapped parking will be enforced!
16. Operate ATV's, off road vehicles or snowmobiles without a permit.
17. Litter or leave refuse in any other than the provided containers.
18. Use a pump or hydrant for anything other than water gathering.
19. Wash clothes, vehicles, food utensils or pollute in any other manner that will harm the natural waters of the district.
20. Swim in any of the natural waters of the district.
21. Operate a boat of any kind on any conservation sites.
22. Ride a bicycle except on those paths, trails that are designated for riding.
23. Kill, wound, collect, release, molest or hunt any plant or animal without a permit.
24. Spray or apply pesticides of any kind.
25. Take any fish, except in accordance with the State of Illinois Fishing Regulations or as posted by the Boone County Conservation District.
26. Build, construct, dump materials, or place any structure, on district lands.
