- A. Preparation of Bids. All bids for the products shall be made only on the blank Contract/Bid form provided in 'Attachment 1' and shall be complete with price and availability for each and every item named. All bids must be signed by an authorized official. Bids that contain omissions, erasures, alterations or additions not called for, conditional or alternate bids (unless called for) or irregularities of any kind may be rejected.
- B. Clarifications. BCCD reserves the right to make clarifications, corrections or changes in this 'Request for Bids' at any time prior to the time bids are opened. All bidders or prospective bidders will be informed of said clarifications, corrections or changes.
- C. Delivery of Bids. **The original copy of the bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked with the Invitation Number and Bidder's full legal name and address.** The envelope shall be addressed and delivered to the BCCD at the Bid Opening Location set forth above, on or before the Bid Opening Time on the Bid Opening Date, set forth above. Bids may be delivered by mail or in person. Bids received after the 'Bid Opening Time' will be returned unopened.
- D. Opening of Bids. Bids will be publicly opened and read at the time and place specified above. Bidders, their authorized agents, and interested parties are invited to be present.
- E. Withdrawal of Bids. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the opening of any bid.
- F. Rejection of Bids. Bids that are not submitted on the Contract/Bid form or that are not prepared in accordance with these Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. If not rejected, the BCCD may demand correction of any deficiency and accept the deficiently prepared bid upon compliance with these 'Instructions to Bidders'.
- G. Acceptance of Bids. Bids submitted are offers only, and the decision to accept or reject is a function of quality, reliability, capability, reputation, and expertise of the bidders. The BCCD reserves the right to accept the bid that is, in its judgment, the best and most favorable to the interests of the BCCD and to the public; to reject the low price bid; to accept any item of any bid; to reject any and all bids; and to waive irregularities and informalities in any bid submitted or in the request for bid process, provided, however, the waiver of any prior defect or informality shall not be considered a waiver of any future or similar defect or informality. Bidders should not rely upon or anticipate such waivers in submitting their bid. Upon acceptance of the successful bidder's bid by the BCCD, the successful bidder's bid, the Contract/Bid form, and the BCCD's notification of acceptance in the form attached to this Invitation to Bid shall become the Contract for the Products.

1.0 Proposal to Deliver Products

1.1 Contract and Products. If this Contract/Bid is accepted, Bidder proposes and agrees that Bidder shall deliver to the BCCD, at the Delivery Address, the products, items, materials, merchandise, supplies, or other items identified in the Request for Bids attached hereto (the “Products”) in new, undamaged, and first-quality condition. Bidder further proposes to:

- A. Labor, Equipment, Materials and Supplies. Provide, perform, and complete in the manner specified and described in the Contract/Bid, all necessary work, labor, services, transportation, equipment, materials, supplies, information, data, and other means and items necessary to deliver the Products to the BCCD in a proper and workmanlike manner.
- B. Permits. Procure and furnish all permits, licenses, and other governmental approvals and authorizations necessary for the Products.
- C. Bonds and Insurance. Procure and furnish all bonds, insurance certificates, and policies of insurance, if any, specified in the Contract/Bid.
- D. Miscellaneous. Perform all other things required of Bidder by this Contract/Bid.

1.2 Performance Standards. If this Contract/Bid is accepted, Bidder proposes and agrees that the Products shall strictly comply with the Specifications attached hereto and by this reference made a part of this Contract/Bid. If this Contract/Bid specifies a Product by brand name or model, such specification is intended to reflect the required performance standards and standard of excellence that the BCCD requires for the Product.

1.3 Responsibility for Damage or Loss. If this Contract/Bid is accepted, Bidder proposes and agrees that Bidder shall be responsible and liable for, and shall promptly and without charge to the BCCD, repair or replace damage done to and any loss or injury suffered by the BCCD as a result of Bidder's failure to perform hereunder.

1.4 Inspection/Testing/Rejection. The BCCD shall have the right to inspect all of or any part of the Products. If, in the BCCD's judgment, all or any part of the Products is defective or damaged or fails to conform strictly to the requirements of this Contract/Bid, the BCCD, without limiting its other rights or remedies, may (i) reject such Products, (ii) require Bidder to correct or replace such Products at Bidder's cost, (iii) obtain new Products to replace the Products that are defective, damaged or nonconforming, and charge Bidder with any excess cost incurred thereby, or cancel all or any part of any order, or this Contract/Bid. Products so rejected may be returned or held at Bidder's expense and risk.

## 2.0 Contract Price Proposal

2.1 Schedule of Prices. If this Contract/Bid is accepted, Bidder proposes and agrees that Bidder shall deliver the Products to Owner in accordance with the Schedule of Prices provided in Attachment 1:

2.2 Basis for Determining Prices. It is expressly understood and agreed that:

- A. All prices stated in 'Attachment 1' are firm and shall not be subject to scalation or change.
- B. The BCCD is not subject to state or local sales, use and excise taxes; that no such taxes are included in the Schedule of Prices in Attachment 1; and that all claim or right to claim any additional compensation by reason of the payment of any such tax is hereby waived and released.
- C. All other applicable federal, state and local taxes of every kind and nature applicable to the Products are included in the Schedule of Prices in Attachment 1.
- D. If a Quantity of Products to be delivered to the BCCD is specified on Page 1 of the Invitation to Bid, such amount is an estimate only, the BCCD reserves the right to increase or decrease such quantity, the total Contract Price to be paid shall be based upon the final quantity determined by the BCCD for each Product and the actual number of Products that comply with this Contract/Bid that are accepted by the BCCD, and that all claim or right to dispute or complain of any such estimated quantity or to assert that there was any misunderstanding in regard to the number of Products to be delivered, is hereby waived and released.

2.3 Time of Payment. It is expressly understood and agreed that all payments shall be made in accordance with the following schedule:

- A. Net 30 days from date of invoice or delivery, whichever is later.

- B. All payments may be subject to deduction or setoff by reason of any failure of Bidder to perform under this Contract/Bid.

### 3.0 Contract Time Proposal

**If this Contract/Bid is accepted, Bidder proposes and agrees that Bidder shall deliver the Products to Owner not later than December 10th<sup>th</sup>, 2021.**

### 4.0 Financial Assurance

4.1 Indemnification. If this Contract/Bid is accepted, Bidder proposes and agrees that Bidder shall indemnify, save harmless, and defend the BCCD against all damages, liability, claims, losses, and expenses (including attorneys' fees) that may arise or be alleged to have arisen out of or in connection with Bidder's performance of or failure to perform under this Contract/Bid, including without limitation any failure to meet the representations and warranties set forth in Section 6 of this Contract/Bid.

4.2 Penalties. If this Contract/Bid is accepted, Bidder proposes and agrees that Bidder shall be solely liable for any fines or civil penalties that are imposed by any governmental or quasi-governmental agency or body that may arise or be alleged to have arisen out of or in connection with Bidder's performance of or failure to perform hereunder.

### 5.0 Firm Proposal

All prices and other terms stated in this Contract/Bid are firm and shall not be subject to withdrawal, escalation or change provided the BCCD accepts this Contract/Bid within sixty (60) days after the date this sealed Contract/Bid is opened.

### 6.0 Bidder's Representations and Warranties

In order to induce the BCCD to accept this Contract/Bid, Bidder hereby represents and warrants as follows:

6.1 The Products. The Products and all of their components, for a period of one year after delivery, shall be of merchantable quality; shall be free from any latent or patent defects and flaws in workmanship, materials, and design; shall strictly conform to the requirements of this Contract/Bid, including, without limitation, the performance standards set forth in Subsection 1.2 of this Contract/Bid; and shall be fit, sufficient and suitable for the purposes expressed in or reasonably inferred from this Contract/Bid and the warranties expressed herein shall be in addition to any other warranties applicable to the Products (including any manufacturer's warranty) or expressed or implied by law which are hereby reserved unto the BCCD.

6.2 Compliance with Laws. Bidder shall ensure that the Products and all of its components shall comply with, and Bidder agrees to be bound by, all applicable federal, state and local laws, orders, rules and regulations as they may be modified or amended from time to time. Every provision required by law to be inserted into this Contract/Bid shall be deemed to be inserted herein.

6.3 Not Barred. Bidder is not barred by law from contracting with the BCCD or with any other unit of state or local government as a result of (i) a delinquency in the payment of any tax administered by the Illinois Department of Revenue unless Bidder is contesting, in accordance with the procedures established by the appropriate revenue act, its liability for the tax or the amount of the tax as set forth in 65 ILCS 5/11-42.1-1; (ii) a violation of either Section 33E-3 or Section 33E-4 of Article 33 of the Criminal Code of 1961, 720 ILCS 5/33E-1 *et seq*; or (iii) for any other reason.

6.4 Qualified. Bidder has the requisite experience, ability, inventory, capital, facilities, equipment, plant, organization, and staff to enable Bidder to deliver the Products at the Contract Price and within the Contract Time Proposal set forth above.

7.0 Acknowledgments. In submitting this Contract/Bid, Bidder acknowledges and agrees that: Contractor agrees to maintain the records and documents for projects of the Public Body in compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq. In addition, Contractor shall produce records which are responsive to a request received by the Public Body under the Freedom of Information Act so that the Public Body may provide records to those requesting them within the time frames required by law. If additional time is necessary to compile records in response to a request, then Contractor shall so notify the Public Body and if possible, the Public Body shall request an extension so as to comply with the Act. In the event that the Public Body is found to have not complied with the Freedom of Information Act based upon Contractor's failure to produce documents or otherwise appropriately respond to a request under the Act, then Contractor shall indemnify and hold the Public Body harmless, and pay all amounts determined to be due including but not limited to fines, costs, attorneys' fees and penalties.

7.1 Reliance. The BCCD is relying on all warranties, representations, and statements made by Bidder in this Contract/Bid.

7.2 Reservation of Rights. The BCCD reserves the right to reject any and all bids, reserves the right to reject the low price bid, and reserves such other rights as are set forth in the Instructions to Bidders.

7.3 Acceptance. If this Contract/Bid is accepted, Bidder shall be bound by each and every term, condition or provision contained in this Contract/Bid and in the BCCD's written notification of acceptance in the form included in this bound set of documents.

7.4 Remedies. Each of the rights and remedies reserved to the BCCD in this Contract/Bid shall be cumulative and additional to any other or further remedies provided in law or equity or in this Contract/Bid.

7.5 Time. Time is of the essence for this Contract/Bid and, except where stated otherwise, references in this Contract/Bid to days shall be construed to refer to calendar days.

7.6 No Waiver. No examination, inspection, investigation, test, measurement, review, determination, decision, certificate or approval by the BCCD, whether before or after the BCCD's acceptance of this Contract/Bid; nor any information or data supplied by the BCCD, whether before or after the BCCD's acceptance of this Contract/Bid; nor any order by the BCCD for the payment of money; nor any payment for or use, possession or acceptance of the whole or any part of any Product; nor any extension of time granted by the BCCD; nor any delay by the BCCD in exercising any right under this Contract/Bid; nor any other act or omission of the BCCD shall constitute or be deemed to be an acceptance of any defective, damaged or nonconforming Product; nor operate to waive or otherwise diminish the effect of any representation or warranty made by Bidder or of any requirement or provision of this Contract/Bid or of any remedy, power, or right of the BCCD.

7.7 Severability. The provisions of this Contract/Bid shall be interpreted when possible to sustain their legality and enforceability as a whole. In the event any provision of this Contract/Bid shall be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, in whole or in part, neither the



validity of the remaining part of such provision, nor the validity of any other provisions of this Contract/Bid shall be in any way affected thereby.

7.8 Amendments. No modification, addition, deletion, revision, alteration or other change to this Contract/Bid shall be effective unless and until such change is reduced in writing and executed and delivered by the BCCD and Bidder.

7.9 Assignment. Neither this Contract/Bid, nor any interest herein, shall be assigned or subcontract in whole or in part by Bidder, except upon the prior written consent of the BCCD.

7.10 Governing Law. This Contract/Bid and the rights of the parties under this Contract/Bid shall be interpreted according to the internal laws, but not the conflict of law rules of the State of Illinois.

## 5. SPECIFICATIONS

### **NATIVE SEED OF VARIOUS HABITAT TYPES**

All seed materials shall conform to the following requirements:

1. All seed shall be guaranteed by the Vendor to be true to species name and variety. All seed shall be a straight species, not a cultivar or other type of hybrid.
2. Preference will be given to seed source origins within 200 miles of central Boone County, IL. These areas include: southeastern Minnesota, eastern Iowa, central to southern Wisconsin, central to northern Illinois, and/or central to northern Indiana. If seed does not originate within this region, the Vendor must indicate the actual origin of their seed.
3. Seed quality requirements:
  - A. All grass species are being requested on a pure live seed (PLS) basis. Vendors must indicate in their response if their seed is not available on a PLS basis.
  - B. All forb and sedge species are being requested on a pure live seed (PLS) basis. However, if pure live seed (PLS) is not available, forb and sedge species seed weights in these specifications will also be allowed, excluding chaff and dispersal appendages. Purity for forb and sedge species must meet or exceed 95% clean seed by weight. Vendor must compensate for seed purities less than 95% by supplying additional material to meet the desired quantity.
  - C. All "bearded" or "fluffy" species are being requested on a de-fluffed (DF) basis. Vendor must indicate in their response if their seed is not available on a de-fluffed basis.
  - D. All "hulled" species are being requested on a de-hulled basis. Vendor must indicate in their response if their seed is not available on a de-hulled basis.
  - E. Any seed received by the BCCD which does not meet bid specifications, will be returned at the Vendors expense, and a refund shall be given.
4. The packaging for each species shall be clearly labeled on the outside with the following information:
  - A. Scientific name of species;
  - B. PLS and bulk weights for grass species, as well as the PLS value;
  - C. Purity and bulk weight (if different from pure weight) for forb species;
  - D. Year of seed production.

5. The Vendor shall provide (upon request) BCCD a written description of the seed materials provided by the Vendor. This description shall include any or all of the following:
  - A. Origin of the various species of seed;
  - B. Name and location of seed supplier, if not from Vendor's nursery;
  - C. The estimated number of seeds per ounce/pound for each of the seed species to be furnished.
6. All deliveries of seeds shall be packaged and delivered to ensure the viability of the seed material upon delivery to BCCD. All seed shall be packed and covered in such manner as to insure adequate protection against damage and maintain dormancy while in transit, storage, and installation procedures.
7. Any delivery/shipping costs shall be integrated into the seed price per oz./lb and the itemized cost. Do not give both a seed cost and a separate shipping/delivery cost.
