

Natural Areas and Resources Technician I/ Non-exempt

The Natural Resources Technician I, under the direct supervision of the Natural Areas and Resources Manager, is a full-time position responsible for:

- 1. Assisting in the implementation of natural resources management on Boone County Conservation District (BCCD) managed lands.
- 2. Having knowledge of native flora and fauna of Boone County, Illinois.
- 3. Safely operating district vehicles and equipment.
- 4. Acting as a crew leader to part time and seasonal staff.
- 5. Working in cooperation with directors, managers, and employees to carry out the mission of the BCCD.
- 6. Understanding all BCCD rules, regulations, and district information and can convey this to conservation area users.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

Assist with establishing and maintaining high quality natural areas on BCCD managed lands 75% of the total time

- Using, loading, and transporting equipment relevant to land management activities.
- Herbicide application and mixing.
- Collection and cleaning of native seed.
- Prescribed burning
- Planting native seed and plants.

Assist with creating and updating site management plans and inventories 15% of total time

- Perform FQA's (Floral Quality Assessments) for BCCD managed lands.
- Create and update site management plans.
- Compile and submit reports relating to land management activities.

Create and present educational public programs on topics relating to natural areas management 5% of total time

- Create and present outdoor presentations relating to land management i.e., nature hikes.
- Create and present indoor presentations relating to land management i.e., PowerPoint presentations.
- Assist with the development of materials that promote district programs.

Other / Misc. 5% of total time

- Attend professional training seminars or workshops.
- Properly file relevant material and paperwork.
- Ability to work overtime and weekend hours.
- Assist in snow removal as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

Required

- Undergraduate Degree relevant to natural resources management and conservation or 5 years' experience.
- Valid drivers license and the ability to obtain a Class A CDL, within 6 months.
- Ability to obtain an Illinois Department of Agriculture Pesticide Applicator Certification, within 6 months.
- Basic computer skills

Additional Knowledge, Skills, or Experience (preferred but not required)

- Chainsaw safety and technique training
- Certification in Adult/Child First Aid and CPR
- Class A CDL
- Certified Il Dept of Agriculture Pesticide Applicator
- Prescribed fire training/certifications
- Familiar with best management practices (BMP's) relating to natural areas management.
- Familiar with commonly used computer programs (Word, Outlook, Excel, etc.).

Physical Functions and Equipment Used

Ability to:

- Lift and carry, bend and reach.
- Go up and down stairs.
- Be able to lift and carry 45lbs.
- Be able to carry 30lbs on your back.
- Safely operate multiple types of district vehicles including but not limited to:
 - Tractors
 - o Skid Steer Loaders
 - o UTV's
 - o Chainsaws
 - o Trucks
 - o Trailers
- Use a computer, smart phone, tablet, copy machine, and other office equipment.

Working Conditions

Ability to:

- Work outside/inside and under all types of weather conditions.
- Work in conditions where there are biting and stinging insects.
- Work in conditions with the possibilities of exposure to minor cuts and burns.
- Work with proper PPE.
- Work in an office setting with regularly scheduled hours.
- Work outside during special events and programs.
- Work some evenings, and/or weekends on a limited basis as needed.

Specific Skills

- English Knowledge of the structure and content of the English language, rules of composition and grammar.
- **Speaking** -- Talk to others to convey information effectively.
- **Reading Comprehension** Understand writing in work related documents.
- Writing -- Communicate effectively in writing appropriate for the needs of the audience.
- Active Listening -- Give full attention to what other people are saying and asking questions as appropriate.
- Ability to contact people by phone, email, and letter.
- Organize, plan, and prioritize work -- Develop specific plans to prioritize, organize, and accomplish work.
